Guest Speakers



Michael Kamm, Professor of Gastroenterology, St Vincent's Hospital & University of Melbourne & Imperial College, London. His main interests are in inflammatory bowel disease, and functional gut and pelvic floor disorders. He publishes and lectures widely and is on the Editorial Board of several international gastroenterological journals, and a number of industry, government and charitable advisory boards.



Lesley-Ann Hanson RN BScN NCA is currently working as a Nurse Continence Advisor (NCA) in the Urogynecology Wellness Program at the Royal Alexandra Hospital in Edmonton Alberta.

Since 1995 she has been working with Dr. Catherine G. Flood and her associates in a nurse run clinic associated with the Urogynecology Wellness Program, assessing and offering non-surgical conservative treatment options to women with urinary incontinence and/or pelvic floor prolapse.



Professor James Gillespie, BSc, PhD, is currently Professor of Human Physiology in the Medical School of the University of Newcastle, Newcastle upon Tyne UK. Over the past few years Professor Gillespie has been focussing upon the smooth muscle of the detrusor and how changes there might be related to bladder pathology. It was from his early work that Professor Gillespie began the work on the 'Autonomous bladder' which was the beginning of a whole new area of 'novel' bladder physiology giving new insights into bladder pharmacology and pathology.



Dr Mark Hutchinson is a NHMRC CJ Martin Fellow at the University of Adelaide. He is recognised internationally as a leader in combining neuroscience, immunology & pharmacology to examine the intricate function of the immune cells (glia) of the brain & spinal cord. His research focuses on the role of glia in neuropathic pain & opioid pharmacology & how these immune-like cells can be targeted by new therapies to treat a range of pathologies.



Peter Stewart is the Clinical Service Coordinator (Charge Nurse) for the South Australian Spinal Cord Injury Service based at Hampstead Rehabilitation Centre. Peter has spent 15 years working with people with spinal cord injuries and has extended experience in the rehabilitation sector. His main interests lie in the challenges associated with the management of neurogenic bowel and bladder, as well as pressure ulcer prevention/management and sexuality and disability.
